On the Family Tree Maker DNA site, you will note that all but one in the R1a1 haplogroup match up REAL close. Look at value of "0" at marker site # 448.

It could be that Charles Hyde, or an unknown brother, may well be the linkage for us. The historical events of Charles are that he was married twice, and we only [so far] know three of his sons: Ansel, Ezekial, and Joseph. Ezekial went to Arkansas/ Mississippi. we have found 4 children for Ezekial. Joseph seems to have dropped off the face of the Earth, but a clue may be in Illinois.

Charles Hyde

Charles Hyde, was a native of England.
Charles Hyde settled in North Carolina in 1770
Served in the Revolutionary War.

Charles Hyde died in 1810 (in Hyde County, North Carolina).
It is noted that Charles Hyde was married twice.
I don't know his second wife's name, nor his children.

By his first marriage he had three children, Joseph, Ansel and Ezekiel.

1. Joseph settled in Tennessee (Where ?)
2. Ezekiel to KY, Ill then settled in Arkansas, Mississippi (Where?)
3. Ansel settled in Hawesville, Breckinridge Co., KY, (for sure) migrated to Ft Hardin, KY in 1796

Ansel moved in 1808 to Rome, Indiana across the Ohio River from Hawesville, KY.

1810 Ansel moved back to Breckenridge County, KY to Cloverport, near the mouth of Lick Run.

In 1815 Ansel moved to Spencer Co., Indiana.

In 1819 Ansel moved into Perry Co., Indiana, to what was known as the Poor Farm.

Ansel and his wife, Mary Miller and her father, Henry Miller are buried in Perry County Indiana.
